

Mohamed Mosadeg (Mohammad Mosaddegh)

Mohamed Mosadeg (Mohammad Mosaddegh) (19. maj 1882. – 5. mart 1967) bio je premijer Irana od 1951. do 1953. Zbačen je sa vlasti u državnom udaru u kome su učestvovala tajne službe SAD. Proslavio se nacionalizacijom naftne industrije u Iranu što ga je dovelo u sukob sa Velikom Britanijom i SAD. Posle svrgavanja tri godine je proveo u zatvoru, a zatim je do kraja života bio u kućnom pritvoru. Mosadeg je postao simbol borbe nerazvijenih zemalja za oslobađanje od kolonijalizma. Njegova kratkotrajna vladavina predstavlja izraz želje iranskog naroda za demokratskim uređenjem.
